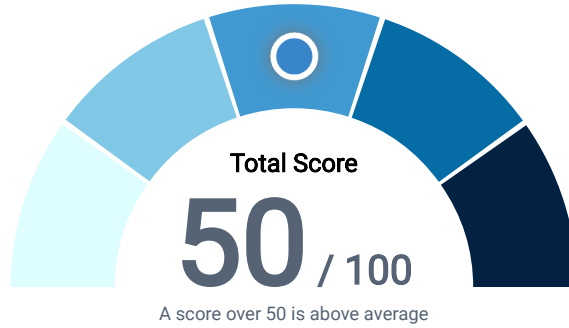

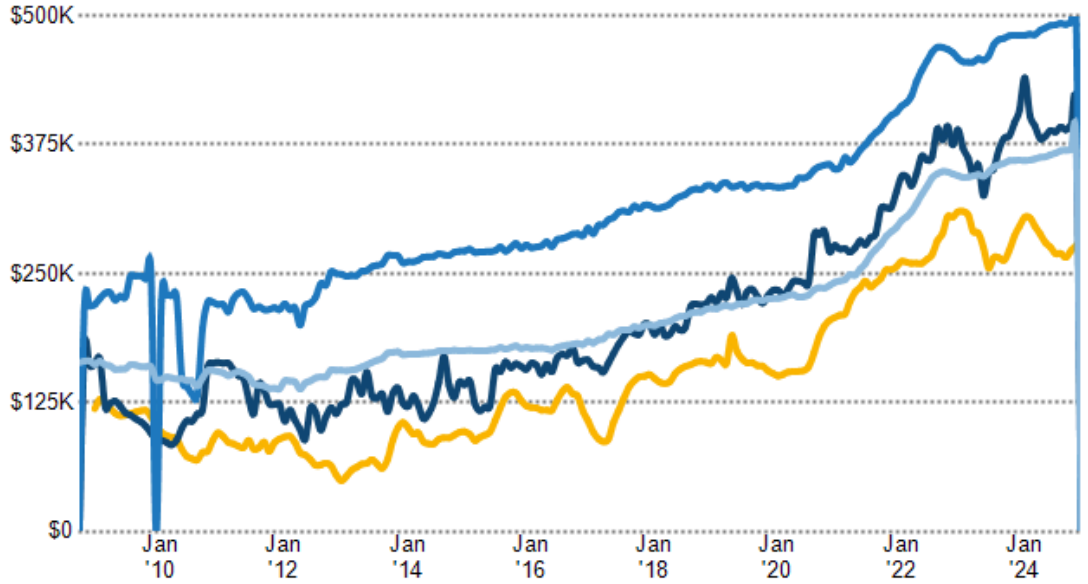

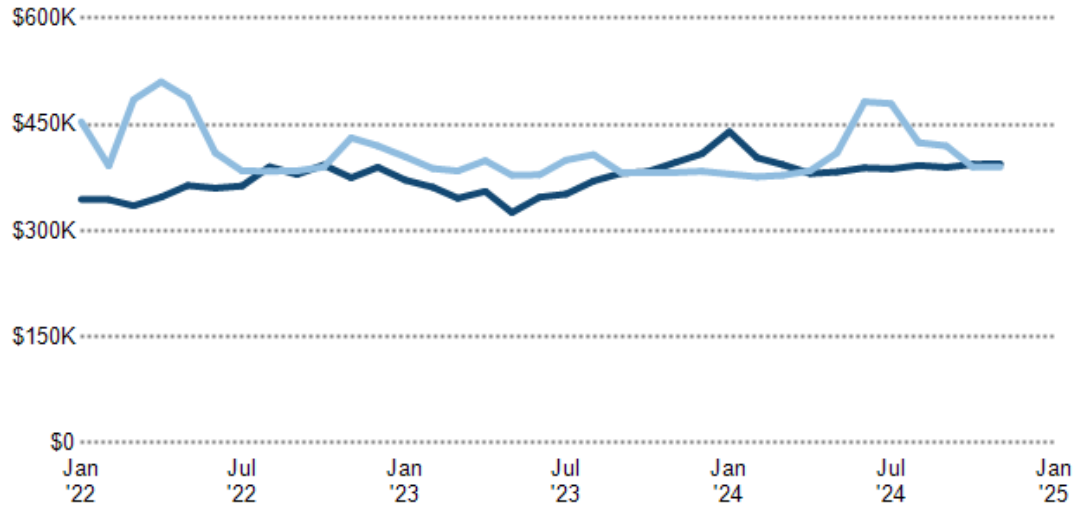

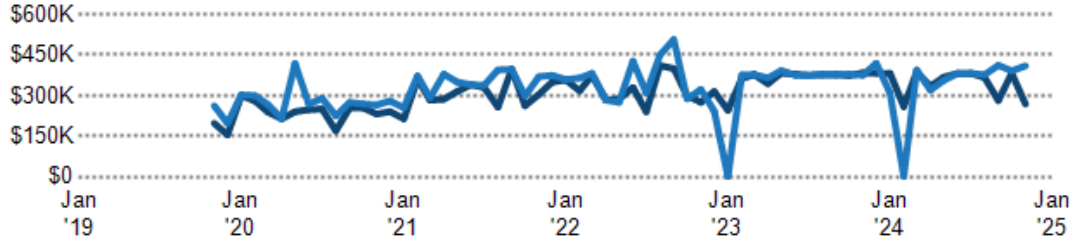

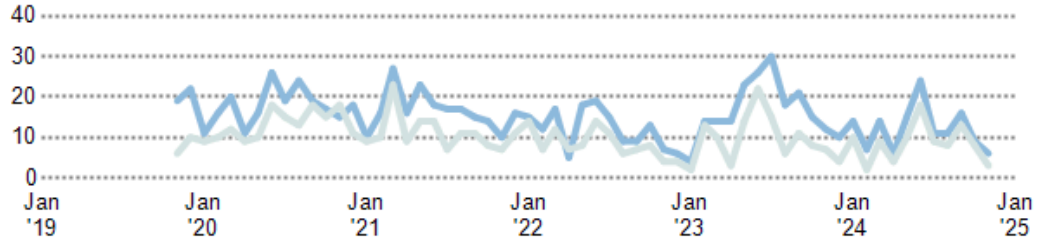

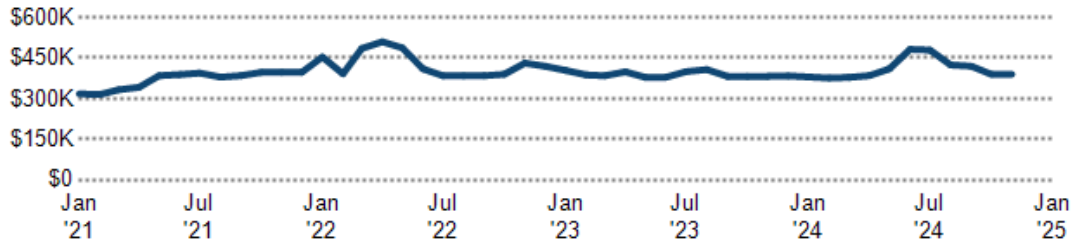

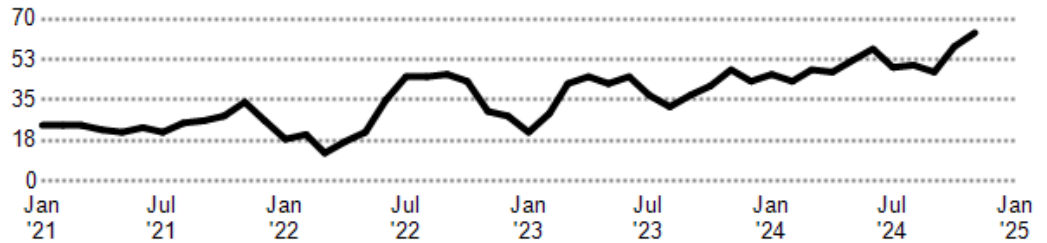

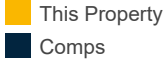

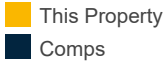

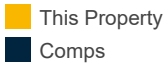


Age Range of Comps Sold

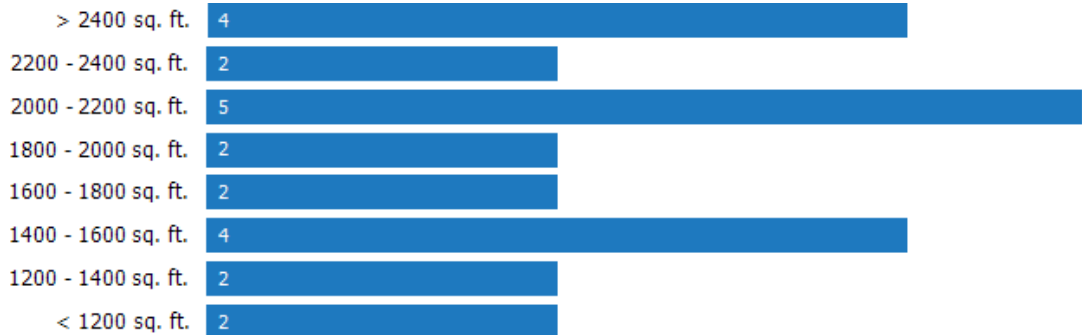
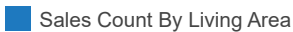


Size of Homes Sold

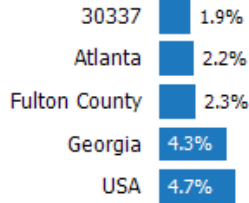

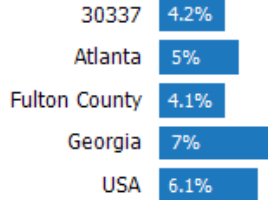

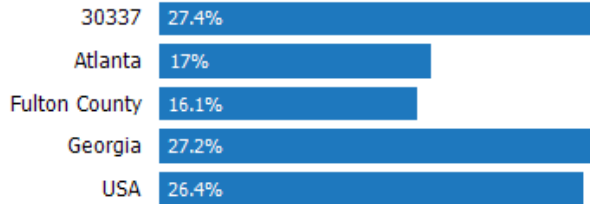

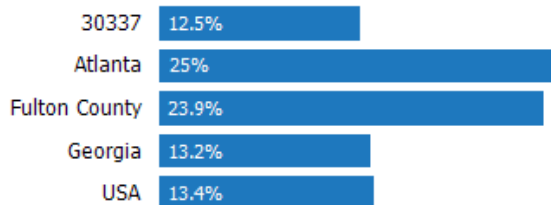

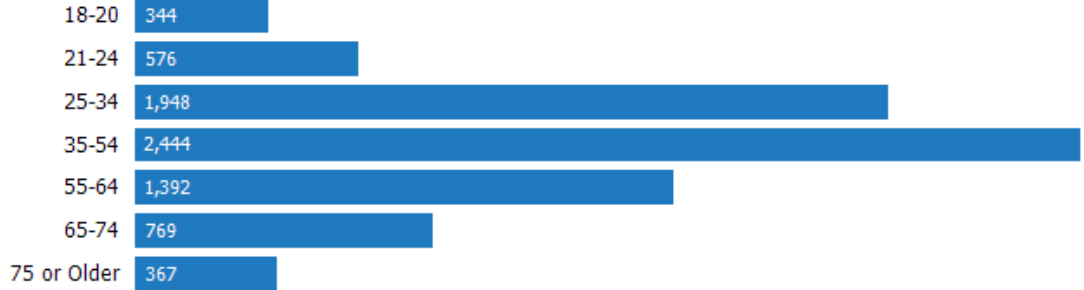
Population of Adults by Age Group

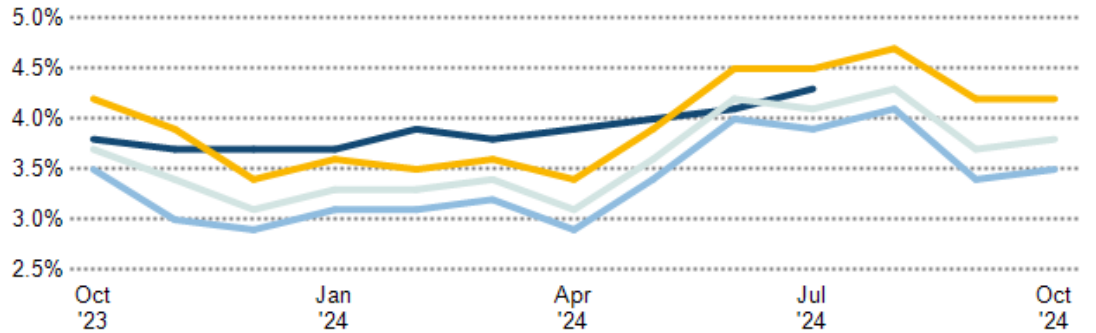

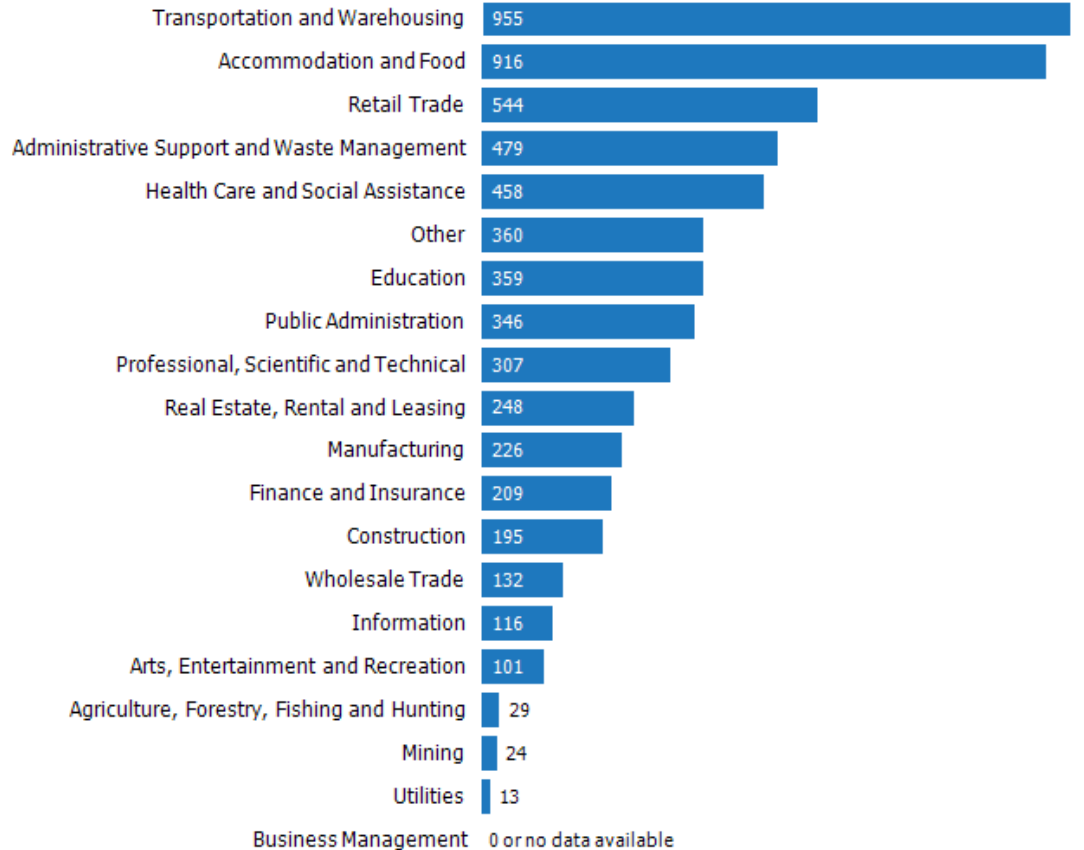


Occupational Categories
