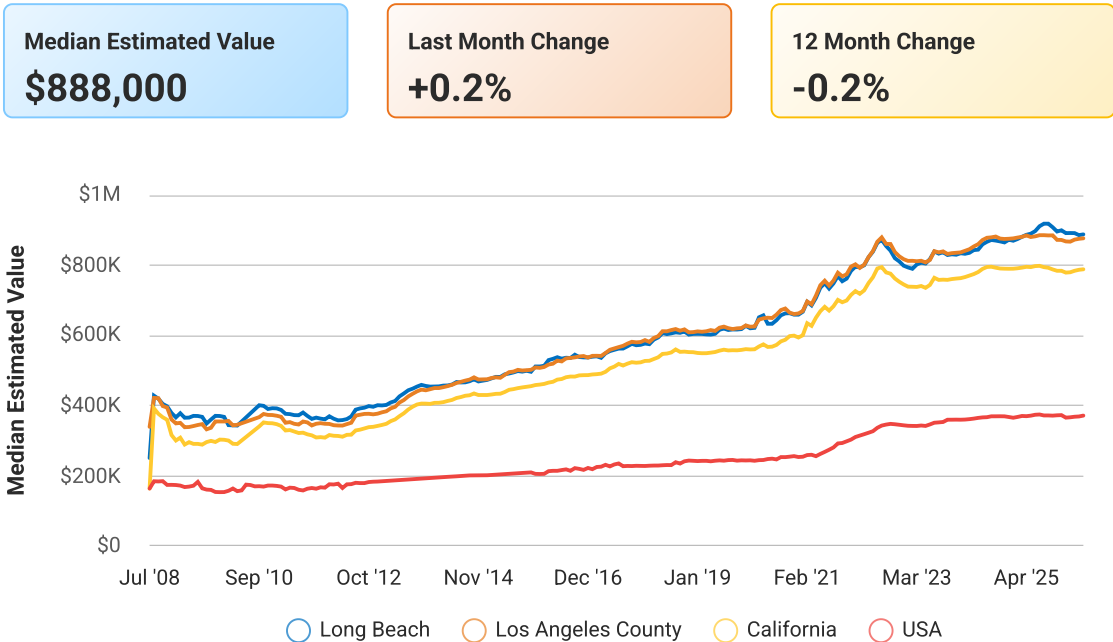

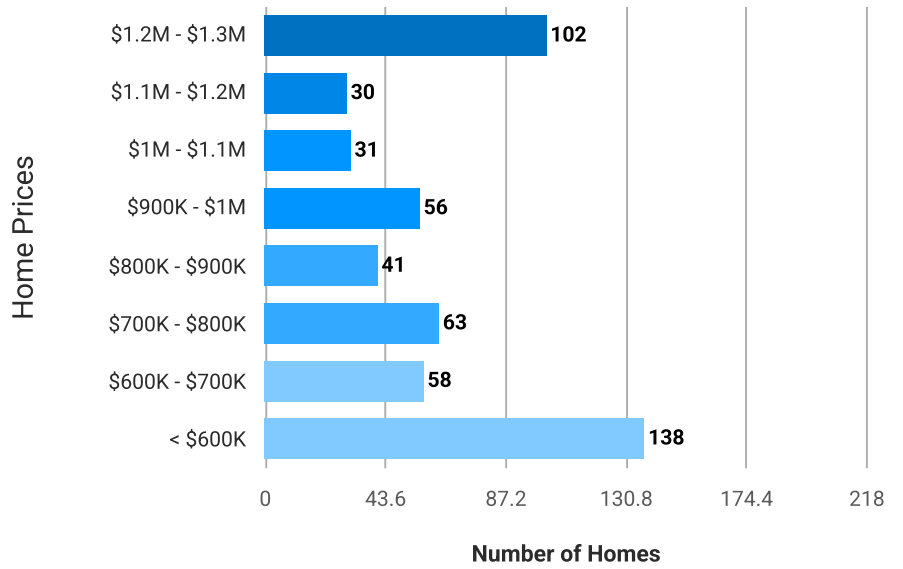

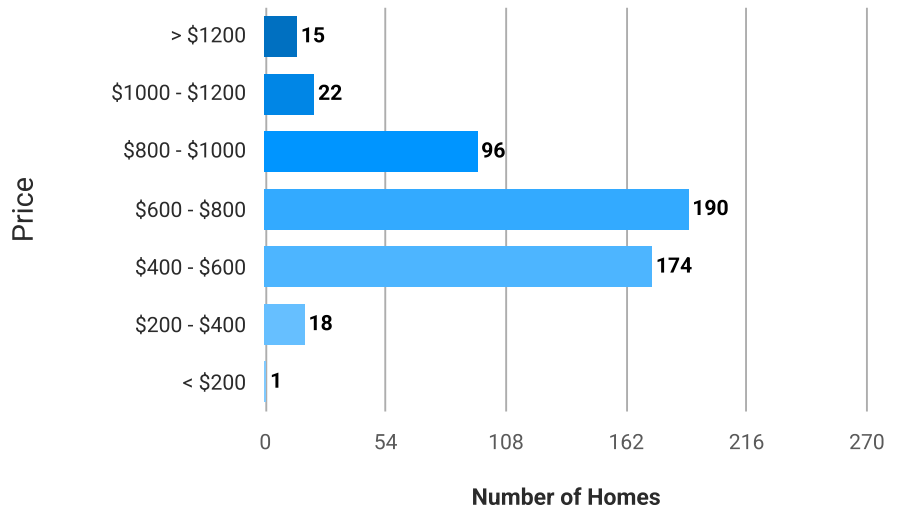


### Price per Square Foot of Comps Sold

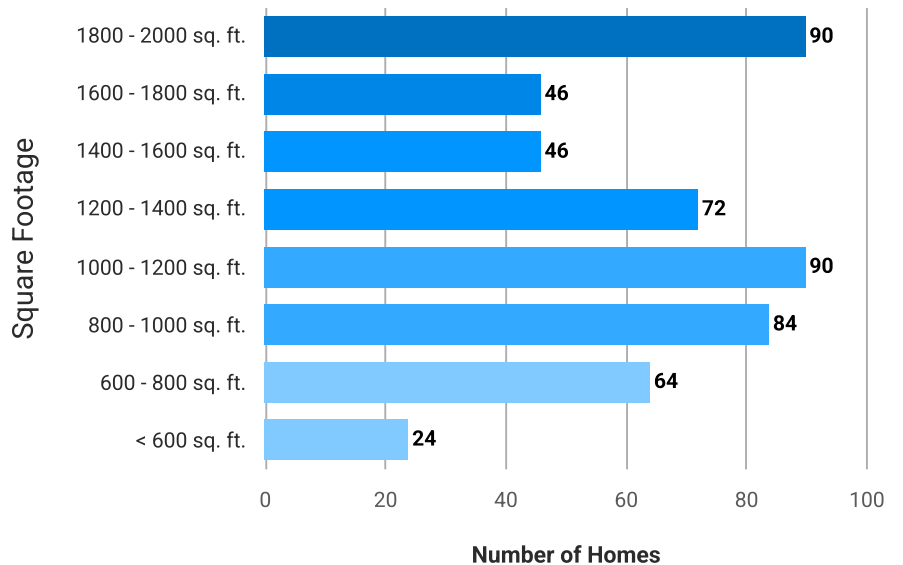


### Size of Homes Sold

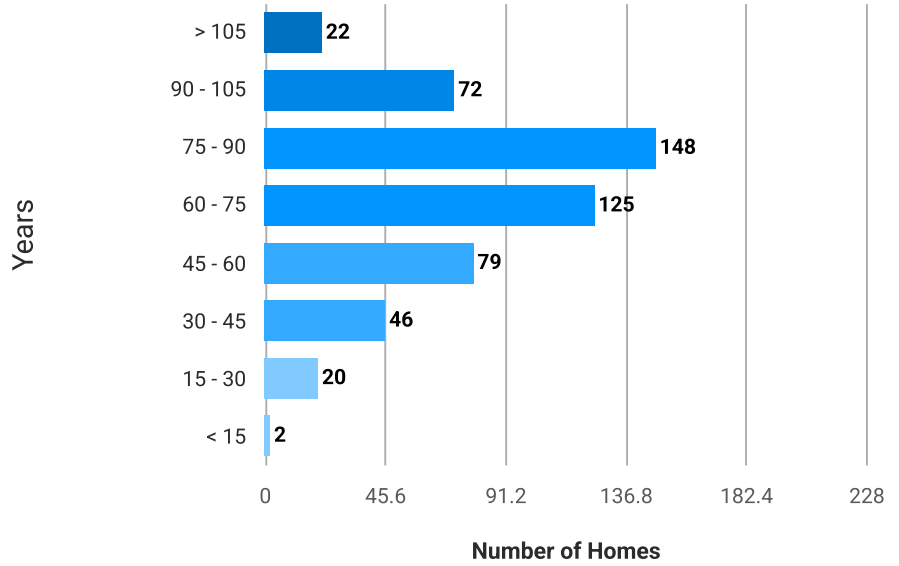

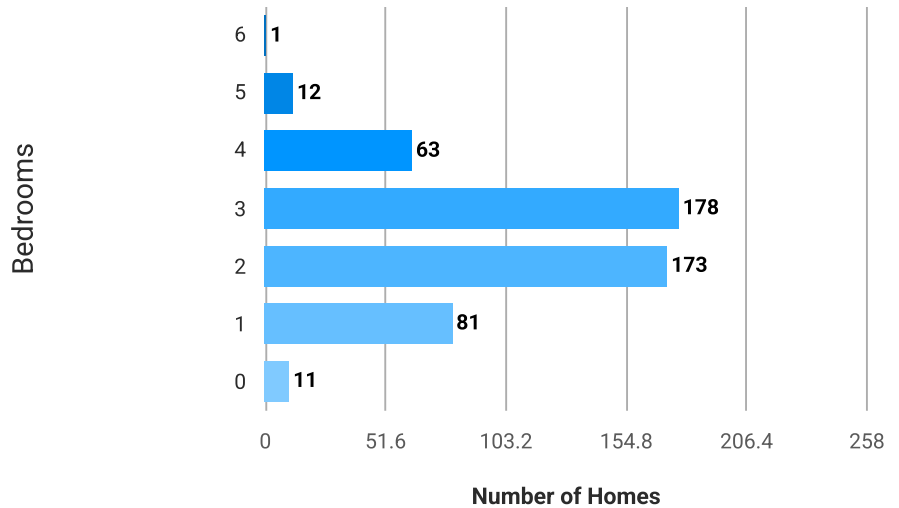


## Number of Bedrooms in Homes Sold

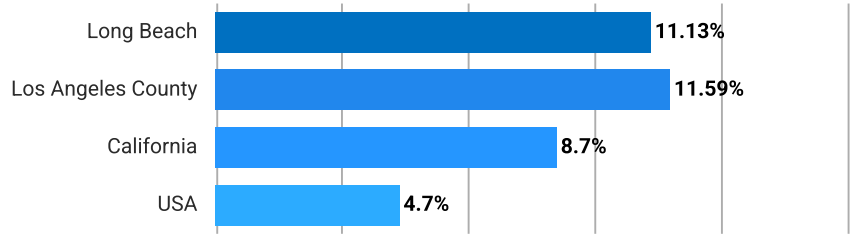

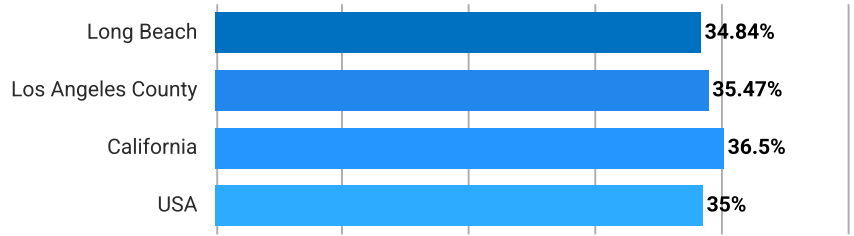

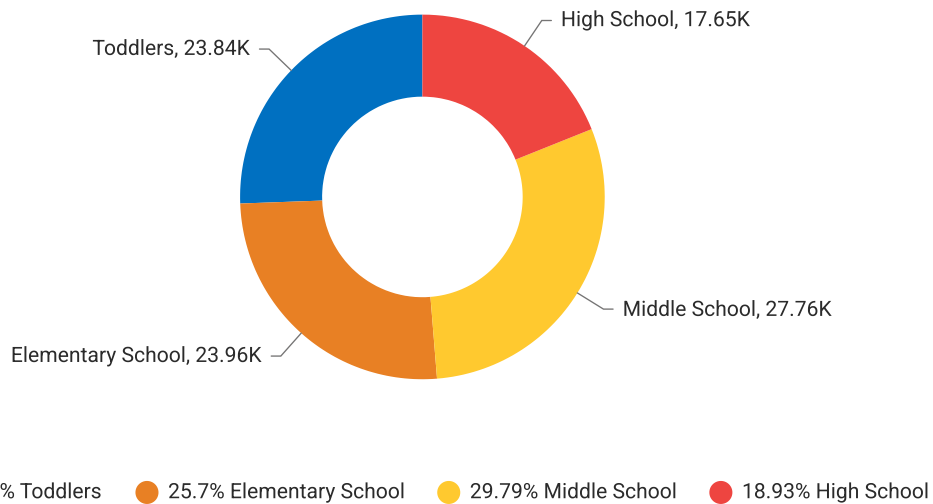


## Population of Children by Age Group in Long Beach

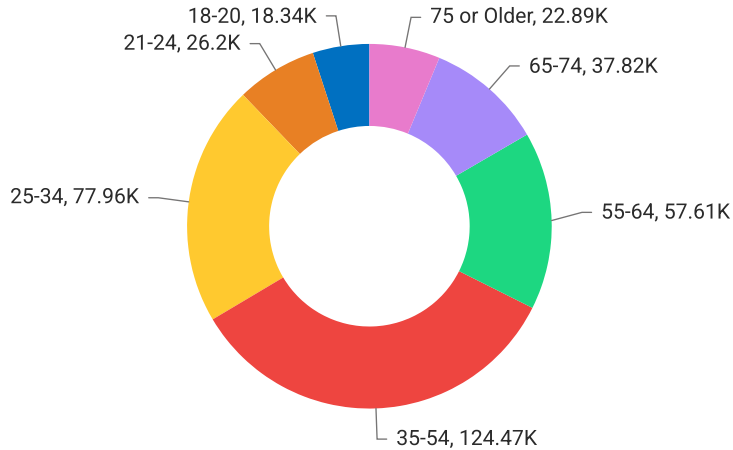

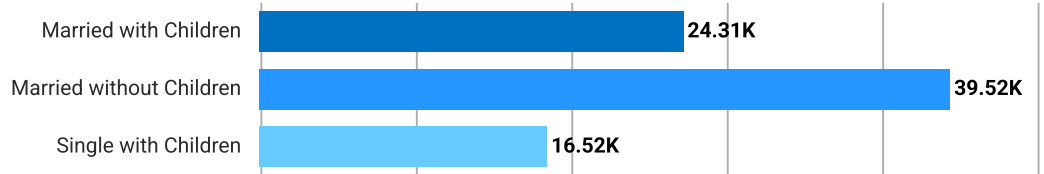


## Households With Children in Long Beach

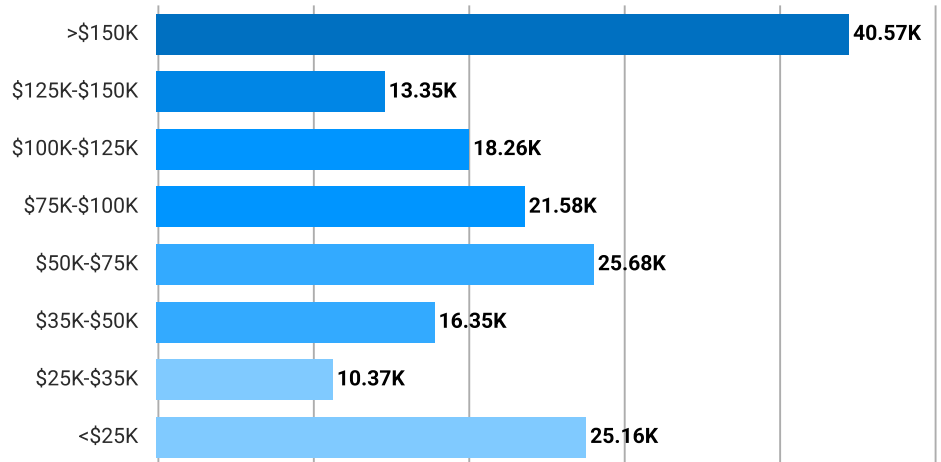


## Household Income Brackets in Long Beach

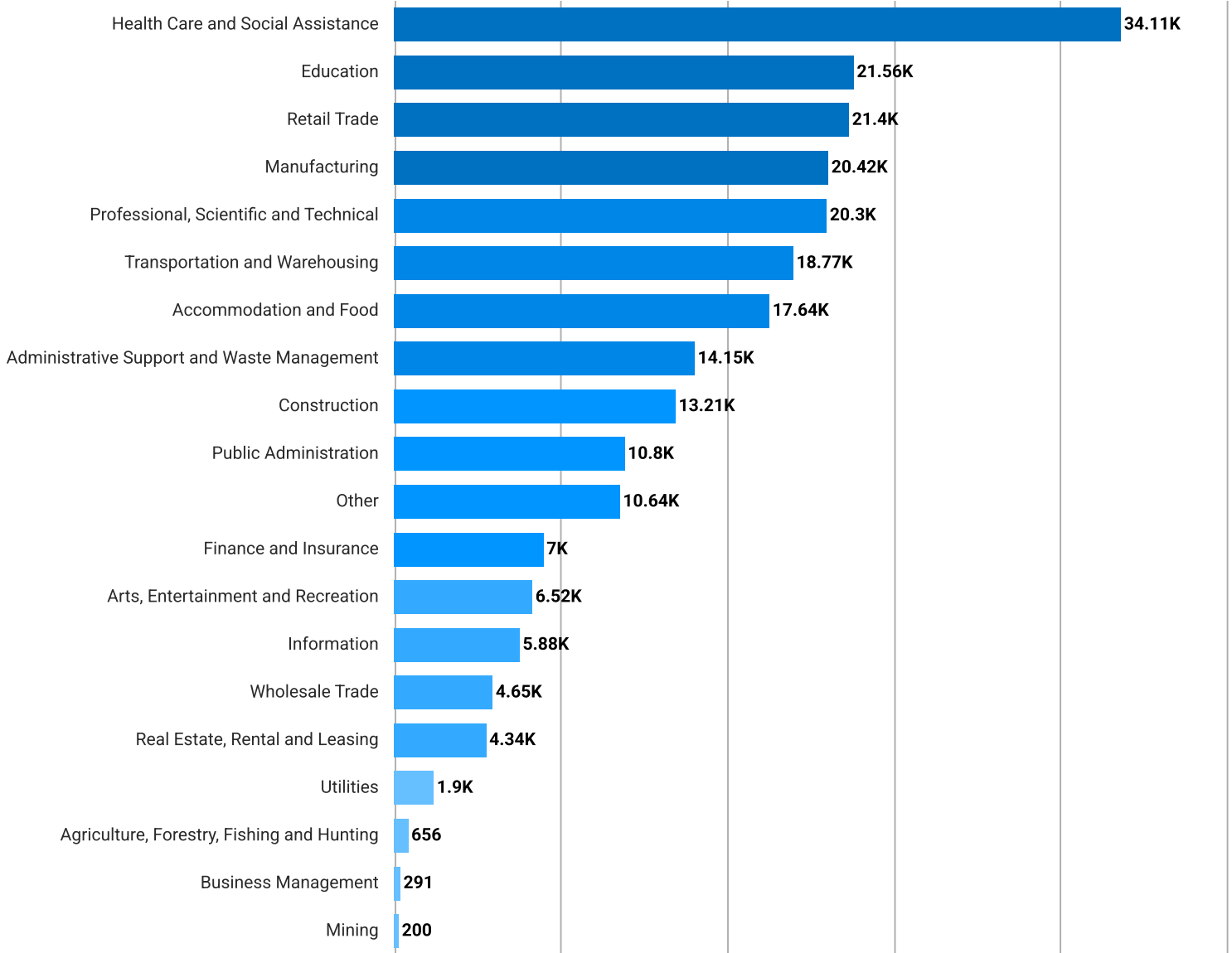

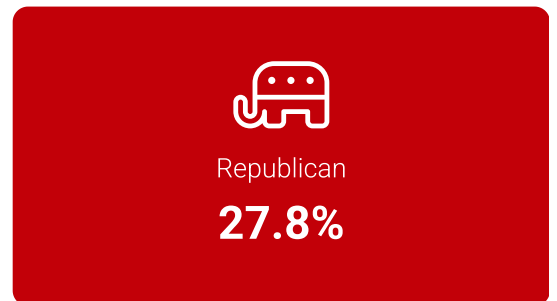
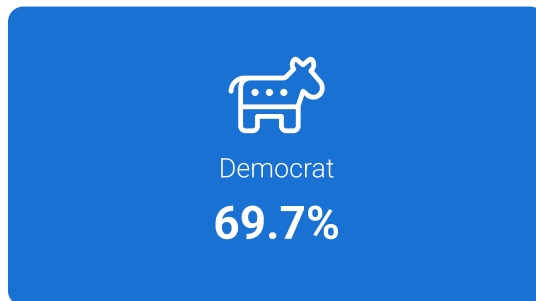


## Presidential Voting Pattern in Long Beach

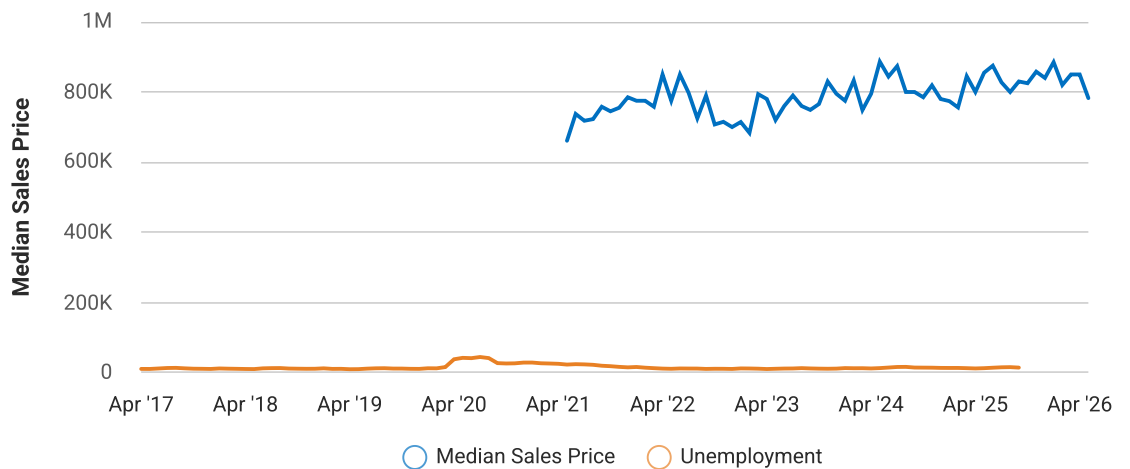

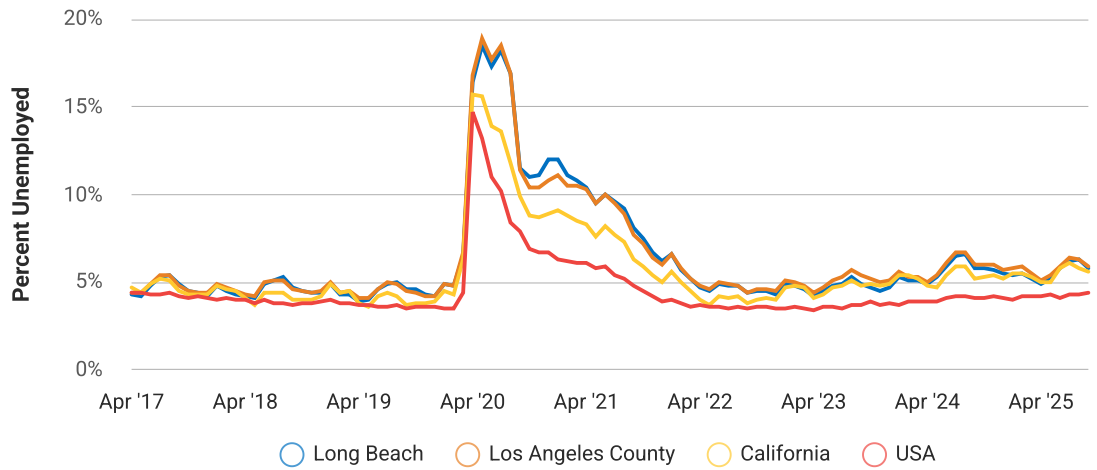

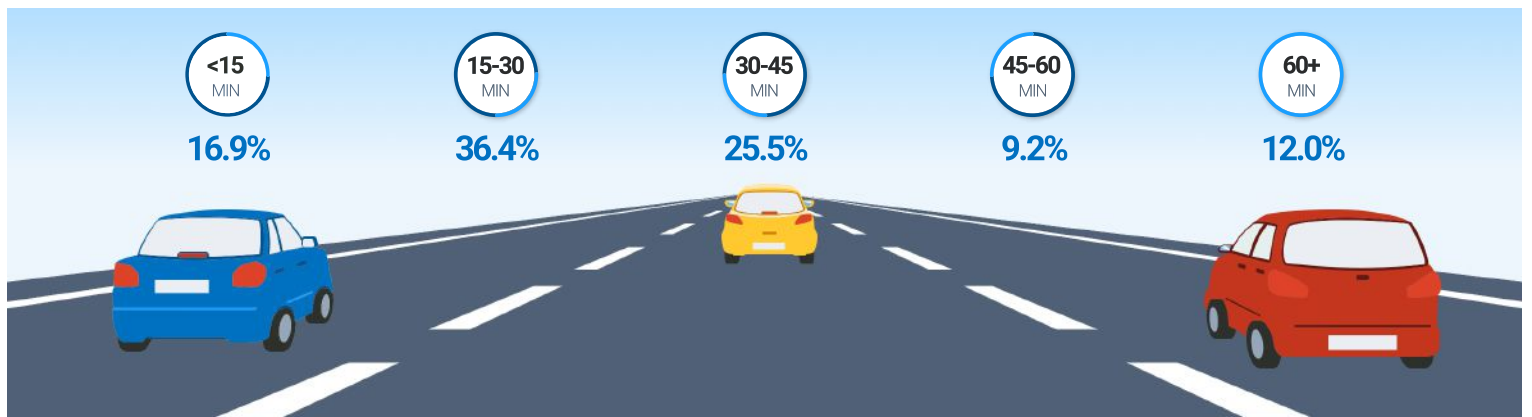

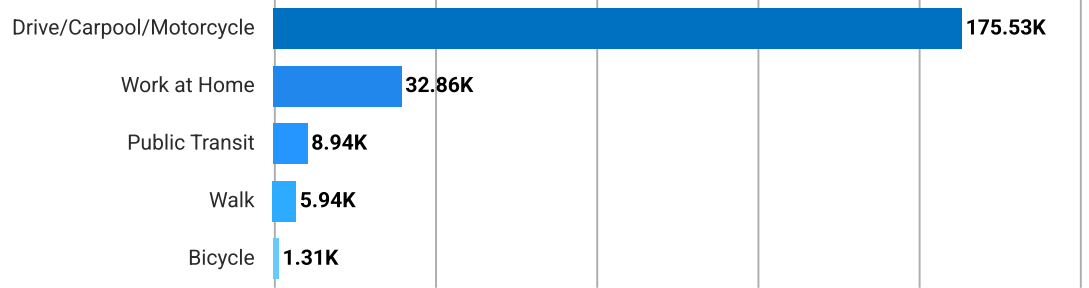

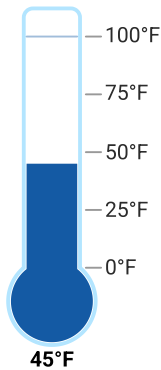
## Average Monthly Temperature

This chart shows average temperatures in the area you searched.

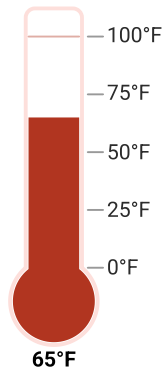

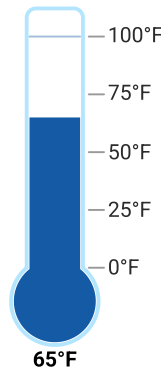

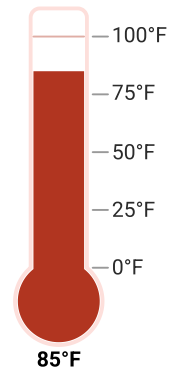
Avg. January Max. Temp
