






### Size of Homes Sold




### Age Range of Comps Sold







### Some High School


This chart shows the percentage of people in an area whose highest educational achievement is some high school, without graduating or passing a high school GED test, compared with other geographies.

This chart shows the percentage of people in an area whose highest educational achievement is high school, compared with other geographies.




## Associate Degree


## Bachelor's Degree






## Population of Children by Age Group in 59715




## Population of Adults by Age Group in 59715






## Household Income Brackets in 59715







## Presidential Voting Pattern in 59715










## Average Commute Time

This chart shows average commute times to work, in minutes, by percentage of an area's population.



This chart shows the types of transportation that residents of the area you searched use for their commute.




## Average Monthly Temperature
