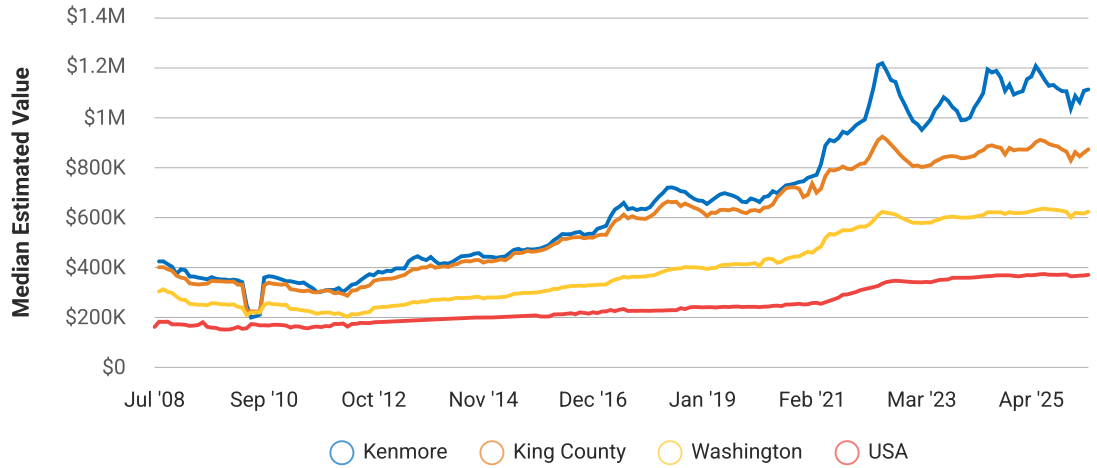

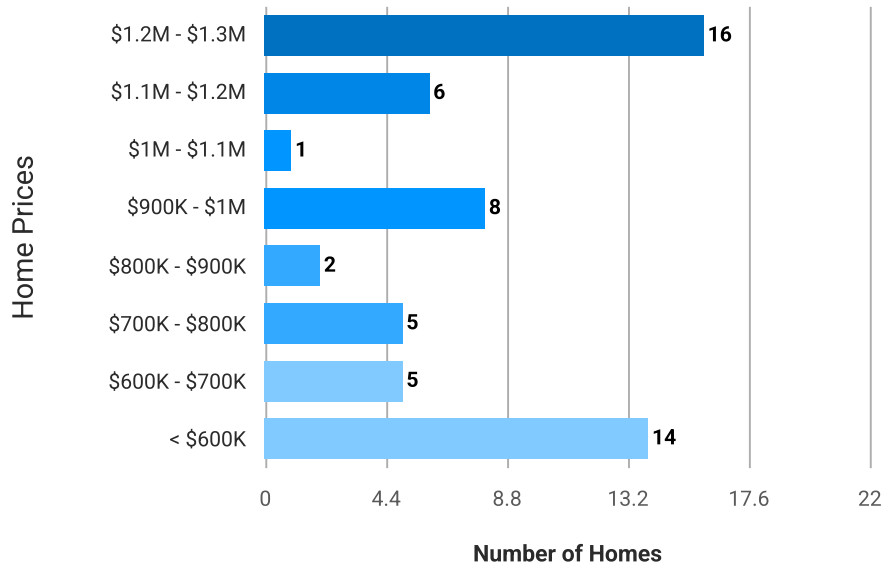

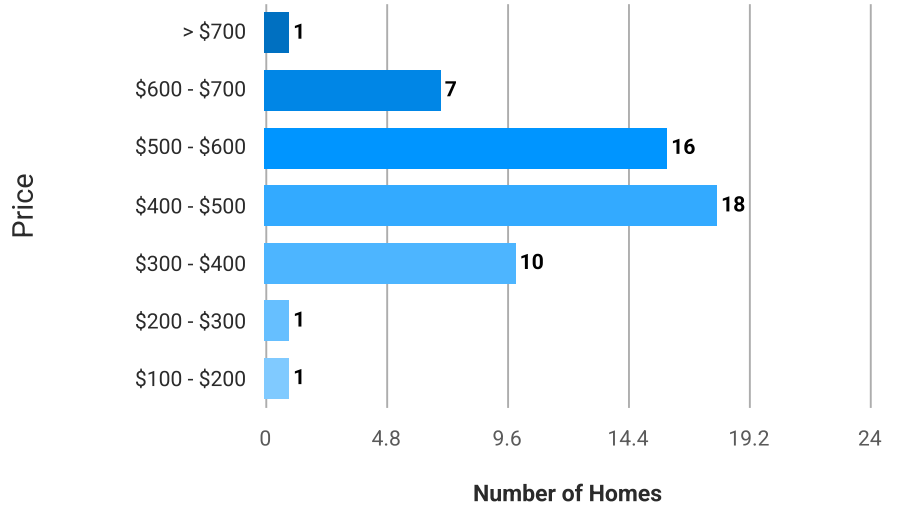

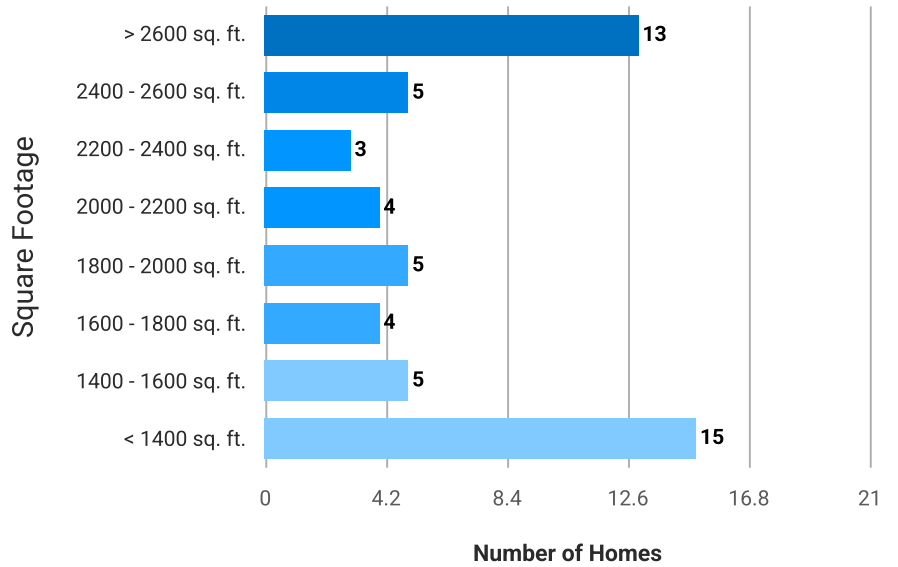


## Size of Homes Sold

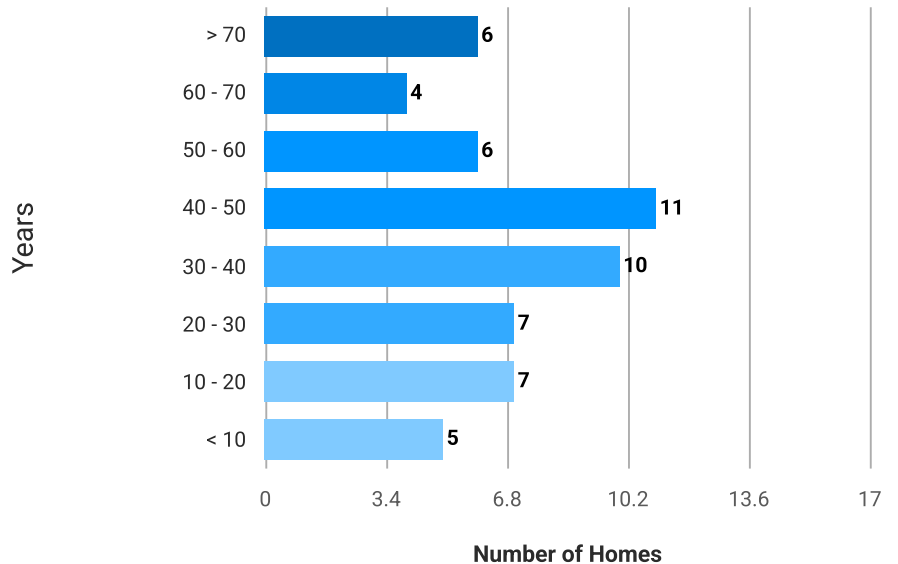


## Age Range of Comps Sold

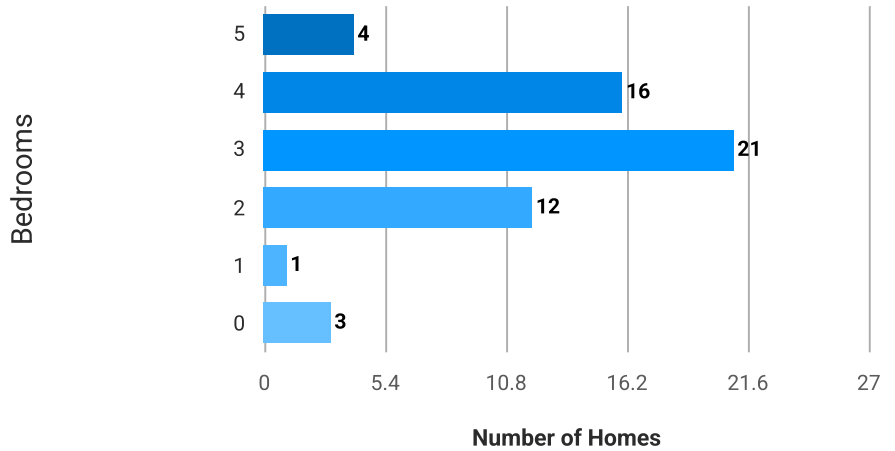

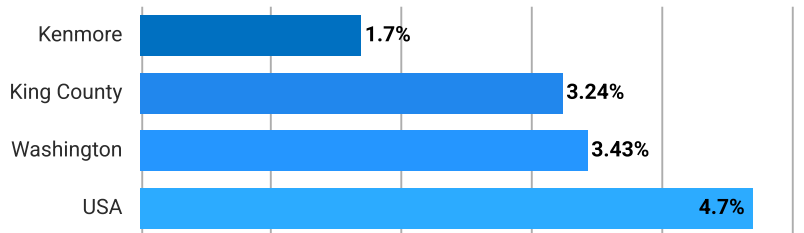

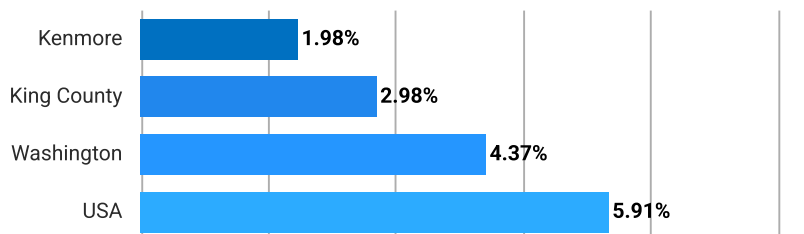

### Some High School

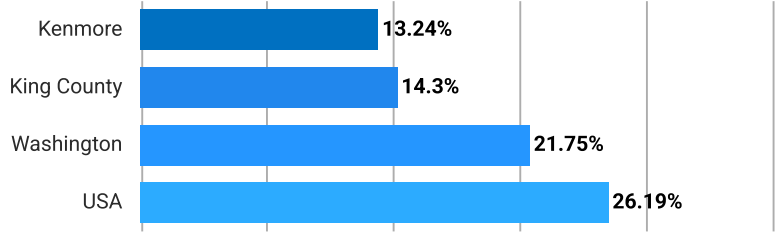
This chart shows the percentage of people in an area whose highest educational achievement is some high school, without graduating or passing a high school GED test, compared with other geographies.

This chart shows the percentage of people in an area whose highest educational achievement is high school, compared with other geographies.



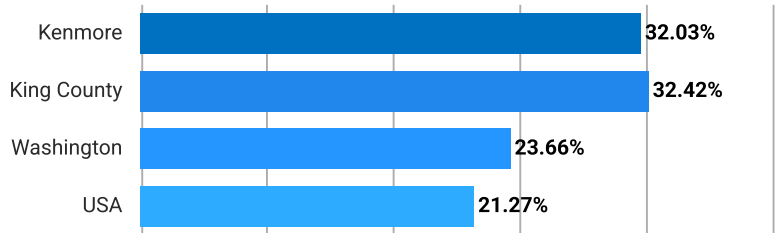
## Associate Degree

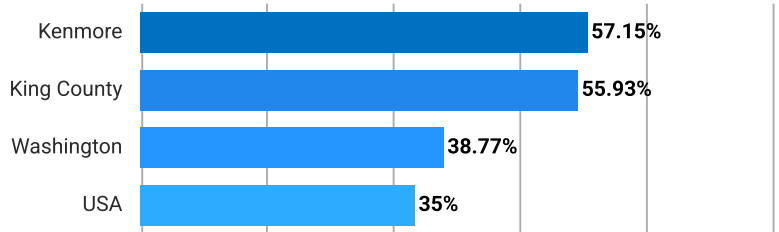

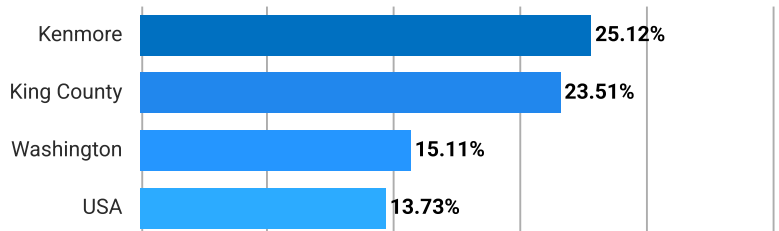
## Some College

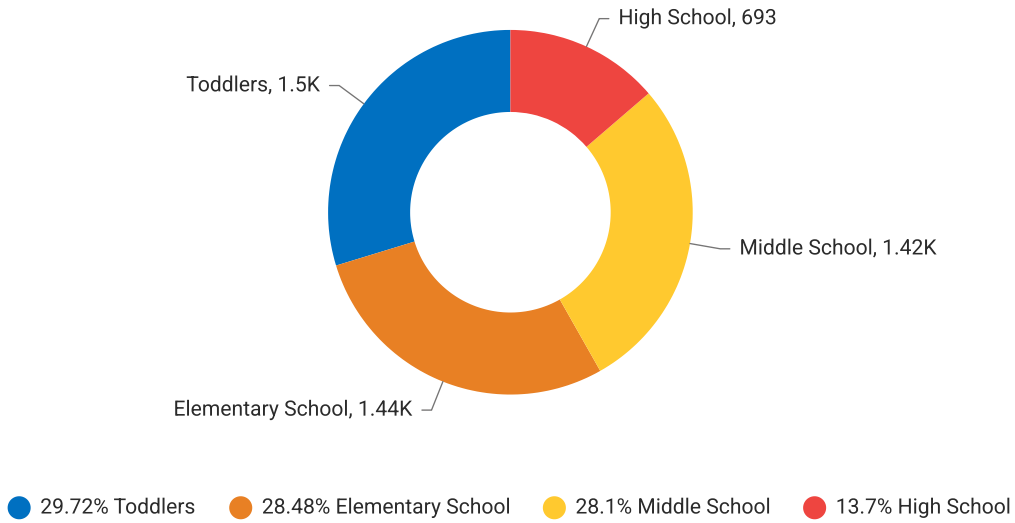

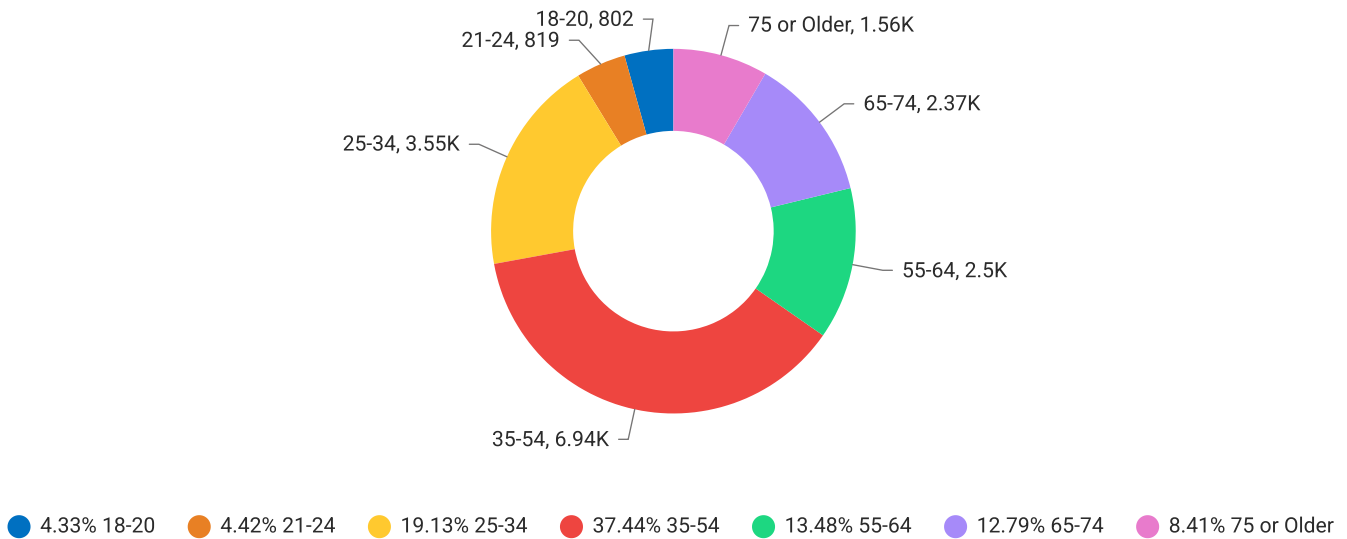


## Population of Adults by Age Group in Kenmore

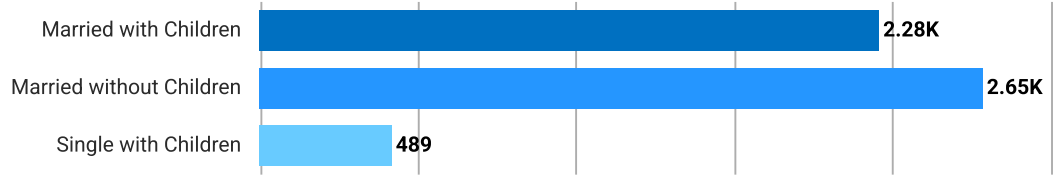

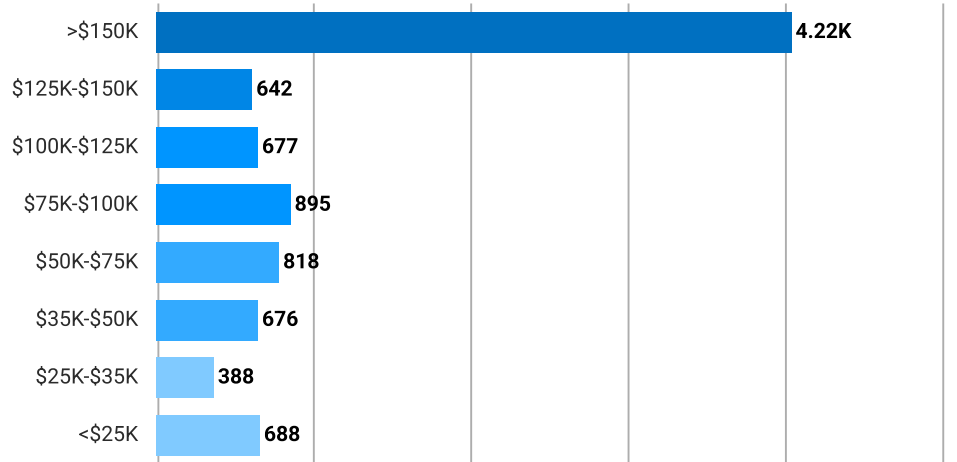


## Household Income Brackets in Kenmore

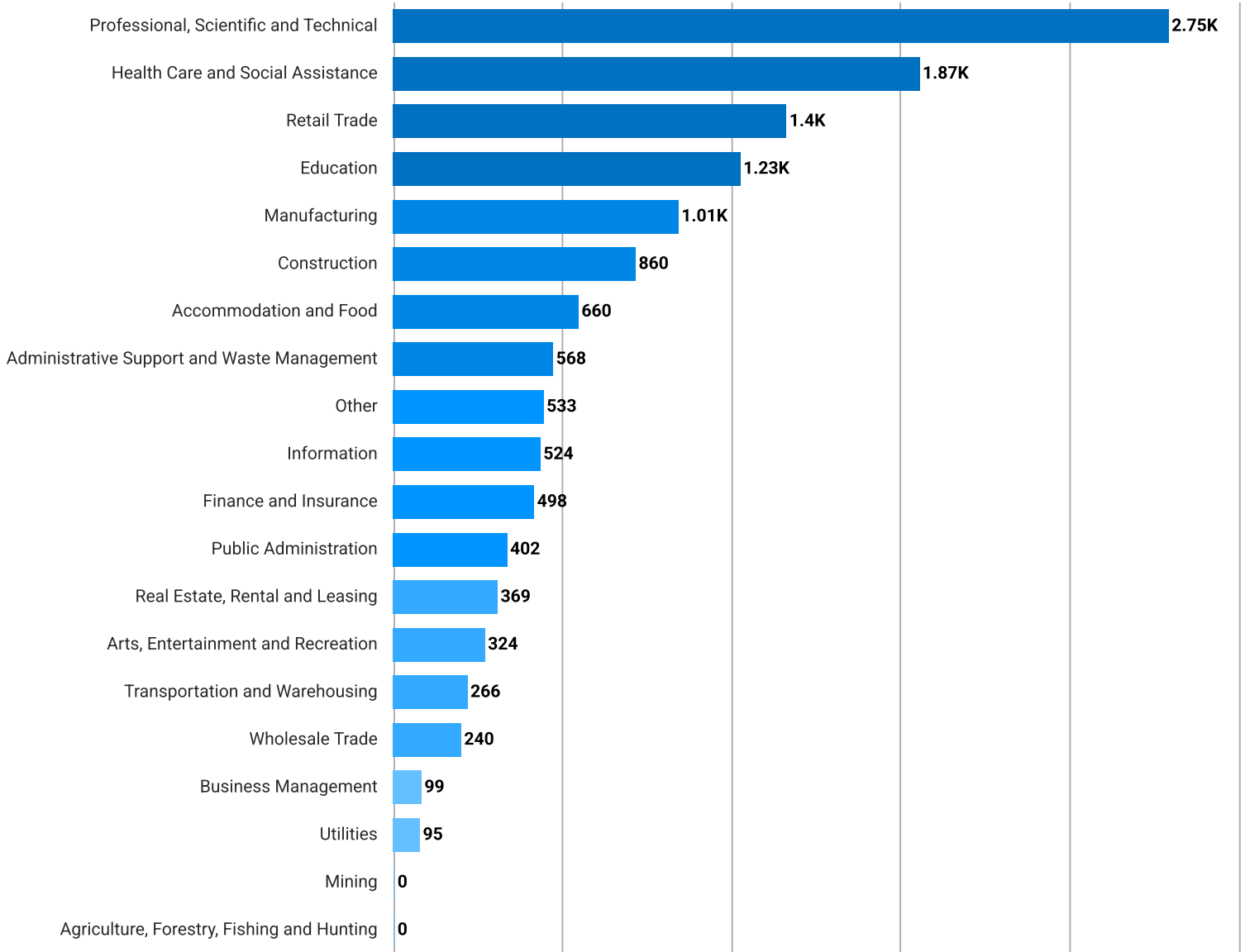

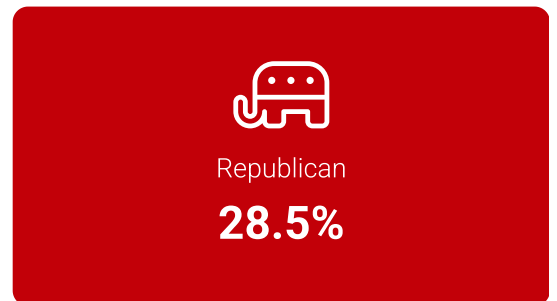
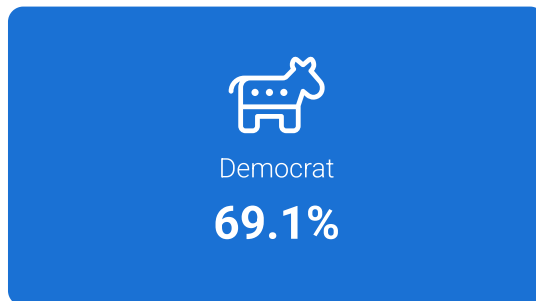


## Presidential Voting Pattern in Kenmore

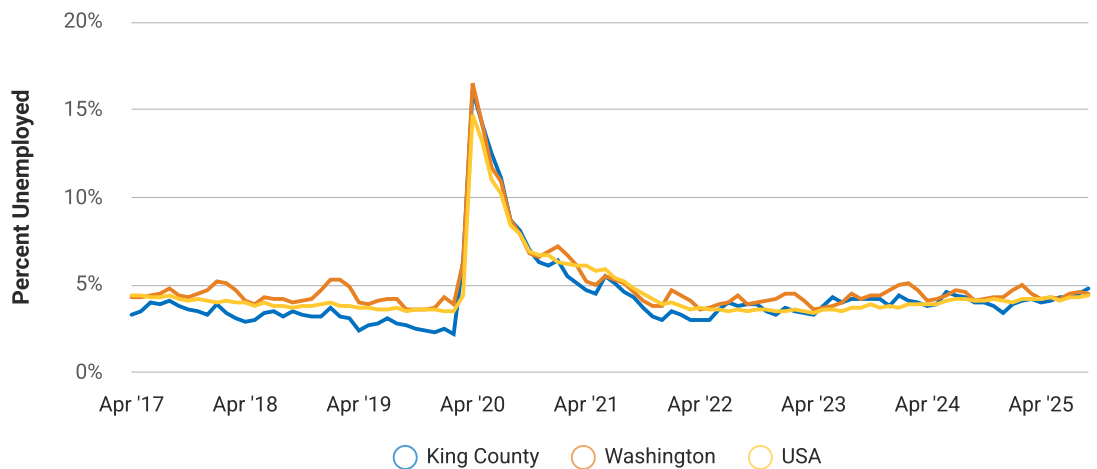

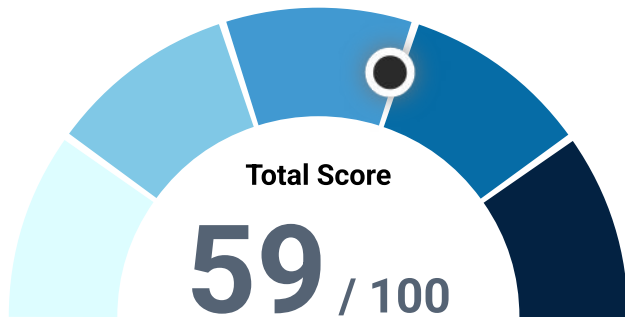

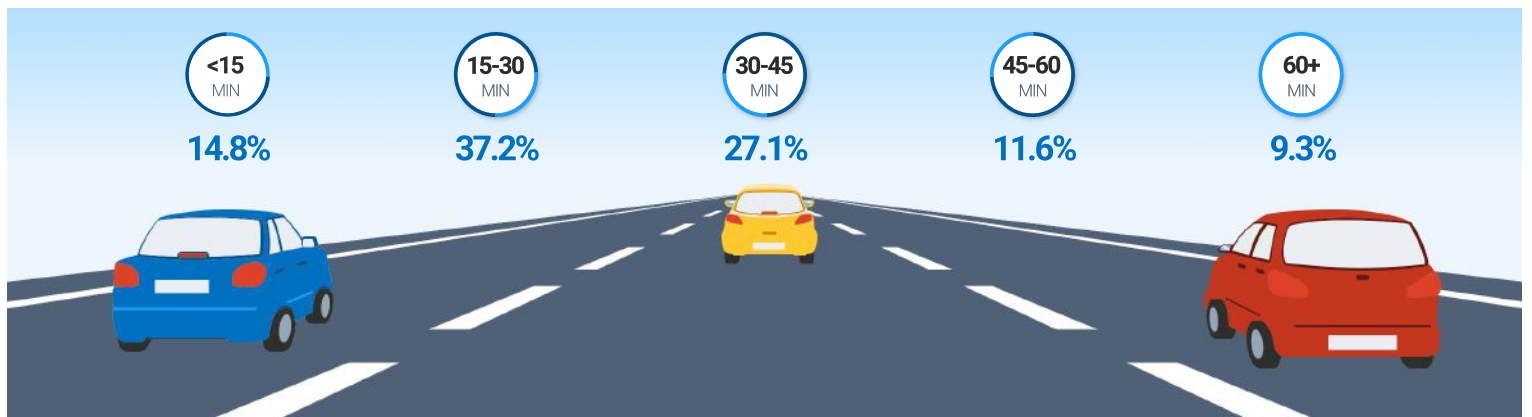

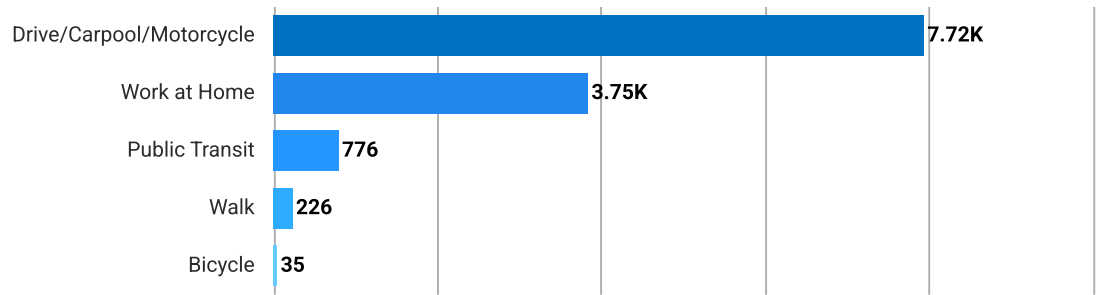

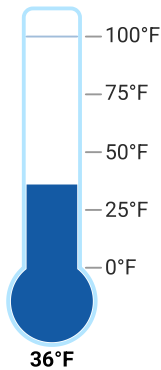
## Average Monthly Temperature

This chart shows average temperatures in the area you searched.

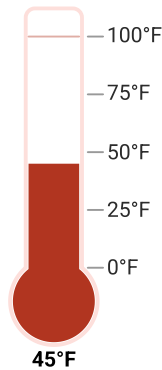

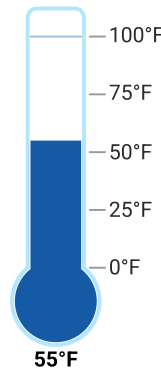
Avg. January Min. Temp



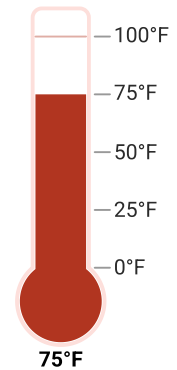
Avg. January Max. Temp
